Arrival & parking

- Please arrive 30 minutes before kick-off so teams can be directed to the correct pitch.
- Parking at Boundary Park is in the marked car park only. Please park considerately and as close as possible to the vehicle next to you.
- Do not park on the grass or on pitch surrounds — ground conditions are often too soft and access routes must stay clear for emergency vehicles.
- Keep the pavilion access lane and gates clear at all times; this is the ambulance route.
- Please car-share where you can — spaces are limited on busy mornings.
- Accessible spaces are reserved for Blue Badge holders.

On arrival

- Your home team manager will meet you and confirm pitch, changing arrangements and kick-off time.
- Team sheets are required for U12 and above — please bring yours completed (see OYFL rules).
- Spectators must stay behind the designated respect line, on the opposite side to the technical areas.
- Dogs are welcome on leads but must be kept off the pitches. Please clean up after them.
- No smoking or vaping anywhere on the site, and no alcohol pitchside.

Club colours

Home	Royal blue shirts with black trim, black shorts, blue socks

If there is a colour clash, please bring an alternative strip; the visiting team changes as per league rules.

Facilities

- Toilets are available in the pavilion during matchdays.
- Refreshments (hot and cold drinks and snacks) are usually available on Saturday and Sunday mornings — cash and card accepted.
- Changing rooms are not routinely available for junior fixtures; please arrive changed where possible.

- Please help us leave the site as you found it — take litter home and return goals/nets as directed.

Codes of conduct

Harwell & Hendred Youth FC follows the FA Respect codes of conduct for coaches, players, spectators and match officials, and we ask visiting clubs to do the same. Respect the referee — many are young officials. Silent sidelines, positive encouragement and fair play are expected from everyone on our site.
